Closed November 24 and December 29, 2018

**What:** Tube TVs for \$25-\$50 depending on size; flat panel TVs for \$20-\$35 depending on size; projection TVs for \$75; large quantities of computers or other electronics will be accepted at a cost of 40 cents per pound.
