

## Northfield Township Human Services Review Commission Qualifications for Members

The members of the Human Services Review Commission must be residents of Northfield Township. Commission members are individuals with backgrounds in community or other volunteer service.

Individuals may volunteer to serve on the Human Services Review Commission, or they may be nominated by members of the Northfield Township Board. Commission membership is not dependent upon race, age, religion or lack thereof, ethnicity, gender, or membership in a political party.

Two members are traditionally high school students from different schools. These members serve two-year terms starting their junior year. Adult members serve staggered three-year terms. The members of the commission select their chair after the deadline for applications to be submitted (in the fall). The Communications & Community Outreach Coordinator acts as staff liaison and secretary.

Commission members are also required to complete the Illinois Open Meetings Act (5 ILCS 120/1) training available online at: <a href="https://foiapac.ilag.gov/">https://foiapac.ilag.gov/</a>.
